<u>Community-Led Local Development (CLLD)</u> is the bottom up tool of the European Structural Investment Funds. Across the European Maritime Fisheries Fund (EMFF), European Social Fund (ESF), European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) and European Regional Development Fund (ERDF), CLLD brings innovative tools and opportunities for coastal and fisheries communities.

Through the work of <u>Fisheries Local Action Groups</u> (FLAGs), these local financing mechanisms enable local communities to initiate, network and scale up the projects of relevance to their areas. Across the 20 Member States implementing this program, Atlantic countries can tap into this network of local initiatives to prompt regional, national as well as transnational cooperation.
